General Overview



THE Camper WAGON

Simple to drive, easy to park, with the same manoeuvrability as a traditional people-mover, this reliable, automatic camper provides a spacious and comfortable driving experience.

THINGS TO NOTE

Be familiar with advisory stickers on the windscreen.

- note unsealed road travelling warnings.
- when driving keep to the left hand side of the road.
- be aware of your vehicle's clearance height (2.3 metres)

Take extra care when parking or turning off the main road.

Tasmania has many mountainous regions. When travelling downhill, choose a lower gear to prevent the likelihood of overheating the brakes.

To reduce the occurrence of condensation during cooler nights, use the heater in conjunction with leaving a window or vent ajar. Some ventilation is important.

Tasmania has many nocturnal animals (active at dusk, during the night and dawn). When travelling at night, we recommend travelling at much slower speeds. Wombats and other wildlife can cause a lot of damage (and road-kill is sad).

During windy conditions we recommend you reduce your speed on all roads as taller vehicles are susceptible to side winds.

Smoking and pets are not permitted in our vehicles.

On return of your vehicle, please ensure the interior is in a clean and tidy state, with all used linen placed in the shower or a plastic bag and the dishes, pans etc are washed.

Familiarise yourself with the vehicle controls and adjust mirrors before setting off.

INSTRUCTIONS



- Use the remote on the key to lock/unlock all doors.
- The vehicle height is 2.3 meters.
- The parking brake is located beneath the dash to the left-hand side of the foot brake, push with your left foot to engage.
- The fuel door release is located to the right of the steering wheel. Push to open the fuel door that is located on the passenger side of the campervans. Use only unleaded petrol.



- If you hired a GPS unit at \$7 per day hire (max \$50), you'll find this stored in the center console.
- Gain access to the living quarters via either sliding door.
- The toolkit and Jack are located in the rear compartment to the left of the sliding door entry.
- The fire extinguisher is located inside near the rear door.
- To use the fridge, plug it into the 12-volt socket in the passenger side foot well. Keep the temperature on maximum and the fridge will cool as you drive.



- To set up the bed, move the two front seats as far forward as possible and store the fridge on the front seat, store any other luggage in the rear compartment or in the roof pod, unfold the mattress for use as a double bed.
- A key for the roof pod is attached to the car key set, to gain access to the pod, open the passenger side sliding door and stand inside on the vehicle floor which will allow you to reach the pod, ensure the pod is locked and secured before traveling.

INSTRUCTIONS



- To set up the awning, first remove the bag from the rear compartment that contains the guide ropes, hammer and pegs. Fully unzip the awning cover, release the two velcro straps within the case, with a person either side, carefully unroll the awning until about a meter from the vehicle, pull out the two legs from within the awning bracket and place them 45 degrees to the campervan. Continue to unroll the awning fully then unfold the two vertical legs and set them to the desired height by rotating the poles to lock them into position. Next secure the horizontal poles into position by twisting them to lock into place and then attaching the velcro straps to hold them secure, ensure the awning is level and taut, attach the guide ropes from the corner of the awning rail to the pegs you have hammered into the ground. To stow away the awning, first remove the guide ropes and pegs storing them along with the hammer back within the rear luggage compartment. Loosen the horizontal poles and place at 45 degrees to the campervan, loosen the vertical poles and reinsert them in the awning rail, fold the awning evenly towards the vehicle and then fold in the horizontal bars into the rail below the case, complete folding the awning into the case, attach the velcro holding straps and place above the cabin.

- For privacy, the hatch on the rear pod can be swung into place. Before driving, fold this hatch flat for better visibility.
- Open the main door on the pod to locate all the cooking items. Cutlery and utensils, the portable gas stove and four spare gas refill cartridges are located in the pod.
- To use the cooker first remove it from the plastic case, swing open the door on the right of the unit that houses the gas cartridge, place a cartridge in the unit and ensure the notch cut out on the can is facing to the top, push the lock lever downwards to engage the gas, turn the dial to max and ignite the cooker flame by using the piezo ignition. Cook outside and let the cooker cool down before storing away.
- The camping chairs, outside table, interior table top and pole are located in the rear under the pod.
- To set up the inside table, place the pole in the hole in the floor, then place the table top on to this.
